



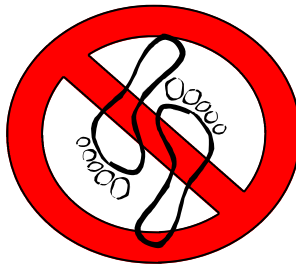
dress regulations

All members are expected to dress sensibly. Their appearance should neither offend or shock others, nor detract from the image and integrity of the Club. The following regulations are to be observed by members and guests whilst on the premises.

not permitted at any time



men must remove caps & hats whilst inside the club



barefooted



sporting footwear with studs or spikes



clothing with racist, offensive or obscene messages or motifs



singlets



dilapidated, worn out or ill-fitting, clothing or footwear

minimum requirement

- Non-offensive apparel
- Appropriately fitting clothing and footwear
- Casual wear that is clean and in good condition

Please think about your appearance; dilapidated, dirty or torn (*including 'designer' tears*) clothing create a bad impression of the club and should be avoided

Fashionably exposed underwear is considered offensive

After playing sport or working, a change out of soiled clothing would be appreciated

a neat and tidy appearance from head to toe is expected at all times
